President-to-be Eldridge informed the Senate that his VP replacement, after a one-semester interim VP, will be selected by 7/1 at the latest. No concrete plan on that yet, but JE would like Senate input on what to prioritize in seeking a new VP.

Dr. Eldridge also asked what the Senate hoped and expected from him as President and asked Senators to reflect on something the new President could do within the first year that would "really knock [their] socks off." He stated that whether or not the VP position would be split into two (instructional and non-instructional) positions was "a good question."

The Senate discussed a few sock-knocking dreams for the college and asked for more time to reflect on the question.

- For the next VP:
 - a. Someone who understands Senate role and shared governance, as well as CA law and Student Services, and who won't be learning on the job.
 - b. Commitment to support 10+1.
 - c. Meet with the candidates in areas they will oversee during part of evaluative interview process.
 - d. Have knowledge and contact with CCC/Vision 2030.
 - e. JE stated that no one who will be applying for the position will be interim VP.
