Faculty have responded hesitantly to a call to evaluate managers with their names attached. Union reps and senate officers are discussing this point.

## IV. Committees Reports

- a. **SLOAC** didn't meet but Logan Wood reported that SLOAC hopes to move the new data dashboard to a public website for PRIE or SLOAC. Data revealed publicly would be at the degree or certificate level, not individual courses.
- V. **OER/ZTC with Invited Guests Sarah Frye and Ron Oxford**. Senators heard an update on the current state of OER and ZTC grants at the College. The State has given 115 million to colleges and will give each college an additional 320k. At COM this will be to create two additional pathways. The Anthropology pathway is underway and must also be completed with these funds. The pathways must lead to a certificate or an AAT. One challenge will be to determine what OER is currently being used at college, because the current catalog is not accurate. Senate will form a working group that will determine which courses and pathways to implement, leveraging more faculty. The librarians emphasized that the library alone cannot achieve the stated goals, and faculty participation is needed. In addition, the Union needs to have a better understanding of what a pathway is so that calls aren't blocked for being too specific. As of now, COM needs to produce three ZTC pathways by Fall 2027 or 2028 (TBD). COM will need to determine a structure for compensation. Ron Oxford will be reaching out to faculty and department chairs. Choice of two new

- pathways and a plan for completion are due May 2. Past managers who are no longer employed by the College also need to be removed as the administrators of the grants and projects on the NOVA website.
- VI. **APs: AP 4100.** Edited language for clarity and inclusion of CALGETC. Questions about catalog rights and outstanding debt remained.
- VII. **Future Business**: Probation AP. AP 7212. AP 4100. Nekoda Harris and Dana Emerson will come next week to discuss screening committees. Susan Rahman is applying for grant for Rising Scholars.
