Catalog Rights

- Students who start Fall 2025 must follow Cal-GETC or local GE (depending on academic goal)
- Students who started prior to Fall 2025 can follow Cal-GETC, CSU GE Breadth or IGETC (as long as they maintain catalog rights AND were not dual enrolled HS students)
- Students maintain catalog rights to any year that they have attended as long as they have maintained "continuous enrollment" (which is attending one semester per academic year)*
 - Each CCC determines their own catalog rights policy
 - o CSUs have catalog rights policy
 - UCs do not have catalog rights policy
- This means that students in the same class will be following different GE patterns!!!!
- Please refer students to a counselor!!!
