Academic Senate Report (Karen Robinson)

- The Senate heard presentations about concerns about campus surveillance and the lack of implementation of an AP that passed the Senate last year.
- Facilities will be installing lighting in parking lot six.
- The Senate created an ad hoc subcommittee to determine who will be helping on the Tech Committee, its charge, and the role of faculty and students in the process.
- The Senate discussed the new comprehensive Program Review proposal.
- The Senate passed AP 5013: Students in the military.
- The Senate will be discussing AP 4105: Distance Education and Program Review at next week's meeting.

Curriculum Chair Update (A Joe Ritchie)

- A Joe distributed several documents to the committee.
- The first document was draft invite language for requesting faculty to present proposals for new courses and programs to the Curriculum Committee before technical review.
- The second document was the Fall 2018 Course Revision list with those courses needing revision by September 1st. A Joe will send electronic copies to the committee.
- The third document was a list of courses not offered since before 2013. This is not a final list and there may be errors on it. A Joe will send electronic copies to the committee.
- A Joe will work to email all faculty with a reminder of the March 1st deadline for new courses seeking articulation for Fall 19 and with the September 1st deadline for the Fall 18 Revision Cycle.
- Next week, call to order will happen at 2:15pm. Nadia Sanko will be presenting new courses from the World Languages and Cultures department. Bob McCoy will also be presenting new courses. In two weeks, Paul Cheney and Stephanie Wells will propose honors curriculum.
- The committee discussed the impact AB 705 will have on Math and English as well as across campus. This will be a future discussion item.

 amount of writing, mode of delivery (e.g. DE), laboratory capacity and safety,
 and so on.
