Presentation:

1. Presentation by Modern Languages

- Nadia Sanko described the core courses in the Spanish sequence from SPAN 101 to 102 to 203. Many students struggle at the 101 and 102 levels (four units each) because the pace of covering the language and other challenges. Some students audit at the 101 and 102 levels to be able to get more contact hours before moving on.
- The department is proposing developing extended versions of 101 (101A and 101B) and 102 (102A and 102) to offer one of the eight 101 sections each semester for students who may need to move at a slower pace. The department proposes that the new courses would be three units each.
- Solano, Napa, Skyline, CCSF, Chabot and other colleges have developed similar curriculum.
- Nadia also presented a proposal for a culture course in French (FREN 98A).
 There is student interest in covering more of Francophone cultures beyond the core courses and the film as conversation courses. Similar courses in Spanish and Italian have been working successfully.

- The committee asked questions and discussed the numbering of courses, the impact on prerequisites, potential conflicts with existing curriculum, impact on degrees, the unit differences.
