POCR Update for Legacy

- Summer went well
- 56 classes need POCR
- 5-6 per semester (based on number of reviewers)
- Everyone was scheduled to meet 9/1 deadline and all have asked for extension
- People don't expect the process to be as much work
- Ingrid is going to do a better job of communicating and reminding them what they need to do to stay on track for completing by the deadline
- Expecting a bottle neck as 2025 approaches
- Need to do more recruiting for reviewers
- It's doable, we just need to be on task
- We have 12 classes completed aligned
- If the course author is not doing the work and we are spending time and money on the reviewer, do we go back to the union and should this course continue to be taught and the person who is not willing to make the changes? This is happening now with courses being taught and it becomes a waste of time/money. What are the limits to POCR in terms of time. If it goes beyond that limit.
 - If it can't get through POCR, it can't be taught.
 - Right of assignment and Dean over rule
- When do we end the POCR process for a course?
 - Put them to the back of the line
