Action Items

1. Agenda

2. Minutes from April 28th
 - a. The committee approved the minutes from April 28th with no amendments.

Discussion Items

1. COM GE Review Process
 - a. OIM and IT are working on extracting a report from the curriculum database to identify courses being proposed for new designation for the COM GE pattern. Dave King will notify the committee of the results and process for review by email.
 - b. The committee determined that this semester it will only review courses that are applying for new designations in the COM GE pattern only. It will wait to determine local designations for new courses seeking CSU Breadth or IGETC AND local COM designation until the results are given from CSU and UC reviewers.

- c. The committee discussed reviewing courses with existing GE designations if they go through substantial changes. The GE Committee will work with the Curriculum Committee to determine what changes would be considered substantial versus what changes would only be minor. This review would not begin until after CurricuNET is implemented, likely for the Fall 2017 revision cycle.
2. GE Proposal on CurricuNET
- a. GE Committee members will provide input on developing the GE proposal form as part of CurricuNET. This will likely happen in a joint meeting of the CC and GEC in November, after technical review has been completed. Dave King and A Joe Ritchie will provide more details as this gets closer.
