Discussion Items

1. Noncredit Training – Grace Yuan
 - Questions and discussions
 - Questions were raised about fees for CPL-ed noncredit courses
 - Rebecca commented that expanding noncredit offerings would provide more options for noncredit students to engage with the college community in a deeper and richer way.
 - The College currently enrolls around 2000 noncredit students
 - Cari asked about the in-state tuition implications once CPL-ed noncredit courses
 - Alex and Sara noted that no CPL for UC transferable courses
 - Additional trainings are needed in Noncredit Pathways to Credit Programs
2. Common Course Numbering Updates – Sara MW
 - Phase II Part A will be in Catalog 2026

- Phase II Part B will be in Catalog 2027
- Most C-ID courses will be developed with a CCN template regardless of whether they are on the Phase III list
- May not be productive to revise course number sequencing in the department to get ready for CCN

3. AA-T in Studio Art – Kevin Muller, Sara MW

- CCN courses are included in the ADT template
- Cal-GETC is the sole GE pattern for this ADT
- ART 130 and 131 have reduced students units by changing unit/hour structure from 3 lec hours/ 3 lab hours to 2 lecture hours/4 lab hours.
- ADT transfer pathways benefit students
 - ADT certification guarantees finishing the Bachelor's within 60 units when transferring into a like major
 - ADT guarantees the lower-division major requirements are all met
 - Particularly beneficial to those who plan to transfer to certain impacted CSU such as San Diego State.
