## **2. Counseling Curriculum Proposal – Gina Cullen**

- New Career Academy Course: COUN 131C "*Careers in Business*"
- Grading: P/NP only
- Funding: District-funded; originated through Strong Workforce

- Scheduling: Offered only in summer for high school students; one-week format
- Demand: Over 120 students expressed interest in a Business summer academy. Currently, the college offers BUS 127 (Entrepreneurship) with a class size of 30. Even with two sections, many students would not have a spot.
- The Business department is supportive.
- Career Academies support dual enrollment.

3. Program Review Update – Alex Jones

- Work is paused until the task group meets a few more times and has more information to share.
- The work completed on the Program Review template appears to be moving in the right direction.
